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## Dehesa del Carrizal Cabernet Sauvignon

Set in the foothills of the Toledo Mountains, between the Tajo and Guadiana rivers, the Dehesa del Carrizal estate is a beautiful, savannah-like landscape where climate, altitude and soil all blend together to create optimum conditions for the 28 hectares of vines. There's a good range of temperatures but the highs aren't too extreme, so grapes ripen at their own pace and absorb the aromas of the surrounding Mediterranean trees and shrubs like olive, cork and oak, or rosemary, thyme and rockrose.

Vino de Pago Dehesa del Carrizal

Grape varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil: Stone and clay

Harvest: Manual

**Winemaking:** Grapes are chilled overnight prior to crushing and fermentation in oak tanks and long periods of maceration. The wine is then left to age for 12-14 months in French oak barrels before spending 2 years in the bottle at the winery prior to release.

ABV: 15 %

Bottle type: Burgundy, 75cl

Closure: Natural cork

**Tasting notes:** Late harvest helps lock in aromas of Mediterranean scrub, spices and minerality. Fermentation in oak, barrel ageing and generous bottle time ensure a firm, well-structured wine with a long finish.
