The Finca Millara estate is set in the heart of the Ribeira Sacra, one of Galicia's five DOs covering 1,200 hectares 80 miles inland from the Atlantic. Vines cling to the steep slopes leading down to the Miño river - heroic viticulture is the phrase coined to describe the work of those who, come harvest time, don harnesses and operate ingenious, cog railway-like contraptions to get the grapes from the vineyard to the winery.

Grape varieties: Mencía

Soil: Slate

Harvest: Manual

Winemaking: Raul Perez, one of Spain's most talented winemakers, oversees production on the Finca Millara estate. Grapes are grown on steep, south-facing plots of decomposing red slate on the Banks of the River Miño. The wine spends 6 months on fine lees before bottling and 6 months in the bottle before release. Voted best Galician red wine of the year in 2017.

ABV: 13 %

Total acidity: 4.96 g/l

Residual sugar: < 1.5 g/l

Total SO₂: 74 mg/l

Bottle type: Bordeaux, 75cl

Closure: Natural cork

Tasting notes: Cherry red with purple streaks, the nose is an explosion of fruit against a balsamic and floral background. Balanced and fresh on the palate.
