Les Sorts Vinyes Velles

Vines, olives and almonds have been the cornerstones of the local economy in the village of Masroig for centuries. The winery was set up in 1917, and they've been making wine there ever since. With members owning a total of 500 Ha, it's one of the largest wineries in the region. Grenache and Carignan are the main varieties, and with dry summers the red clay soil helps absorb the scarce winter rains and release them throughout the summer growing season.

DOP Montsant

Grape varieties: Carignan, Garnacha

Soil: Limestone, red clay, slate

Harvest: Manual

Winemaking: Traditional fermentation with malolactic fermentation in barrel. No clarification and light filtering. 17 months ageing in French oak followed by 24 months in the bottle before release.

ABV: 14.5 %

Bottle type: Bordeaux, 75cl

Closure: Natural cork

Tasting notes: Dark cherry red with violet tones. Complex aromas on the nose, with red and black fruits dominating with notes of black pepper, clove, cocoa, Mediterranean brush. Warm and round on the palate with mature tannins. Long, pleasing finish.
