The Pazo As Barreiras estate is in Condado del Tea, one of the five sub-zones that make up the Rías Baixas DO. The estate's 10 hectares of vineyard is given over entirely to the Albariño grape, planted on limestone and clay soil with stones. The Atlantic climate and high rainfall help produce wines with relatively low alcohol content and high aromatic expression.

DOP Rías Baixas

Grape varieties: Albariño

Soil: Limestone, clay

Harvest: Manual

Winemaking: Grapes are de-stemmed before undergoing a light pressing. Must is then racked and fermented for 15 days in stainless steel tanks at 17°C. No malolactic fermentation.

ABV: 13 %

Total acidity: 5.4 g/l

Residual sugar: 1.2 g/l

Total SO₂: 127 mg/l

Bottle type: Burgundy, 75cl

Closure: Synthetic cork

Tasting notes: Aromas of apple, pineapple and citrus fruits. Aromatic and delicate palate with good balance.
